

Phoenix and Youth ATV Blank Key Part numbers:

Part# 0453143 RH Groove, 0453372 LH Groove Groove is determined when holding the key, ready to put into ignition. RH is right hand, LH is left hand

RANGER/RZR/ATV: To identify which series the key is, take the first two digits on the original key and refer to the chart below for the proper part number. The part number for 31 is part # 4110141. That is the number that you would need to order the blank key. For 4000 series blanks, reference all 4 digits stamped on the blank.







Victory Replacement Keys

The key identification number (1) is stamped on the key blade. If the key and the identification number are lost or misplaced, the lock set (contains ignition switch, fuel cap and saddlebags/trunk if equipped) must be replaced. Key blanks are available as service parts. Locksmiths familiar with the motorcycle industry will be able to cut a replacement key with either the original key or key I.D. number and a Victory key blank.

1999-2007 Victory motorcycles use key blank 4110239 2008-2013 Victory motorcycles, except Vision, use key blank 4110239 2008-2013 Victory Vision uses key blank 4012155



Indian Replacement Keys


We only offer pre-cut keys for Indian Motorcycle, 2009-2013, and they are ordered using the code on the key. If both keys have been lost, the ignition will need to be replaced.

The code will have multiple numbers, look for the "A" followed by a 1 or 2 digit #. The key is ordered according to this number using the prefix N611010 followed by the numbers after the A. For example "A12" would be part # N61101012.

The Indian Key cover is part number N61100006

2014-Current

Key Blank Identification: The key number is stamped on the bow of the key as indicated in the image below. The proper replacement key is determined by the first digit of the key code. For example for key code <u>0</u>221, the 0 would indicate keyway "0". Referencing key code <u>1</u>221, the 1 would indicate keyway "1". If both keys are lost or misplaced, the lock set must be replaced.
