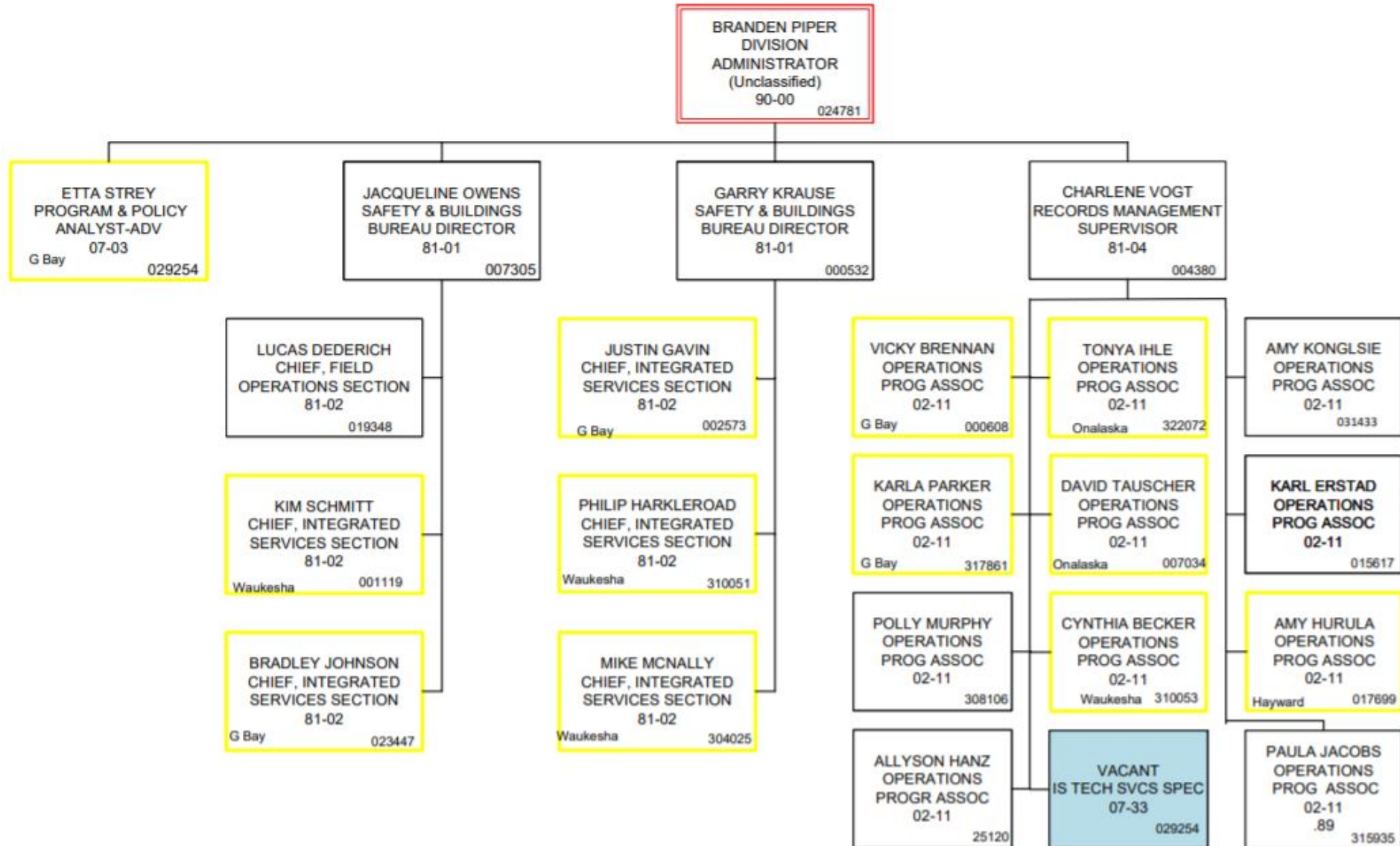

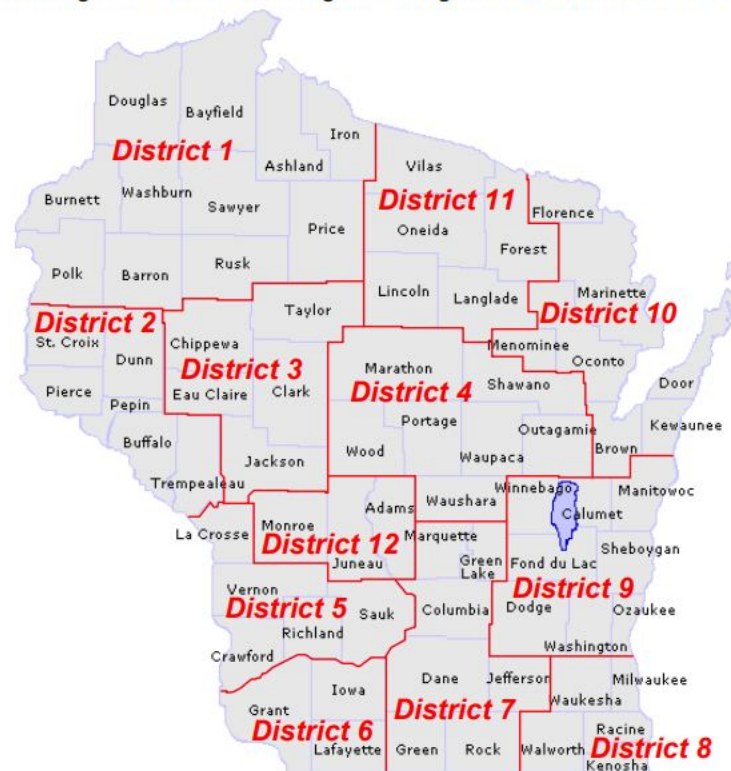

- Plan ahead as much as possible
- Plan are submitted electronically
- Take the time to fill out the application correctly
 - Include all necessary documentation
 - Use the checklist

TRIAGE:

Plumbing Staff triage the plans before the a review date.

Approximately 50% of plans go on hold during triage. Submission time for a plan will indicate the date which the complete plans are received.

Plans are assigned a tentative review date and are reviewed by the next available, qualified reviewer.

Permission to start requests are **NOT** permitted for:

- *Subsurface infiltration system plans*
- *Detention system plans*
- *Grease interceptors (when by itself)*
- *Catch basins (when by itself)*
- *Interior above ground installations*

PERMISSION TO START (PTS)

Requirements:

- Owners Signature
- Completed Checklist.
 - [ChecklistPlumbingPlans.pdf \(wi.gov\)](#)
- Designer's Signature.
- All Plan Submittals Shall Include the Requirements of 382.20.
- All Applicable calculations: Storm, Water, etc.
- All required plan sheets: Isometric Plans, Floor Plans, Site Plans, etc.
- Plumbing specs and schedules separate from plans in one combined set.

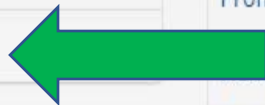

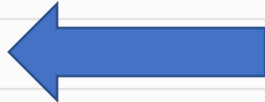
